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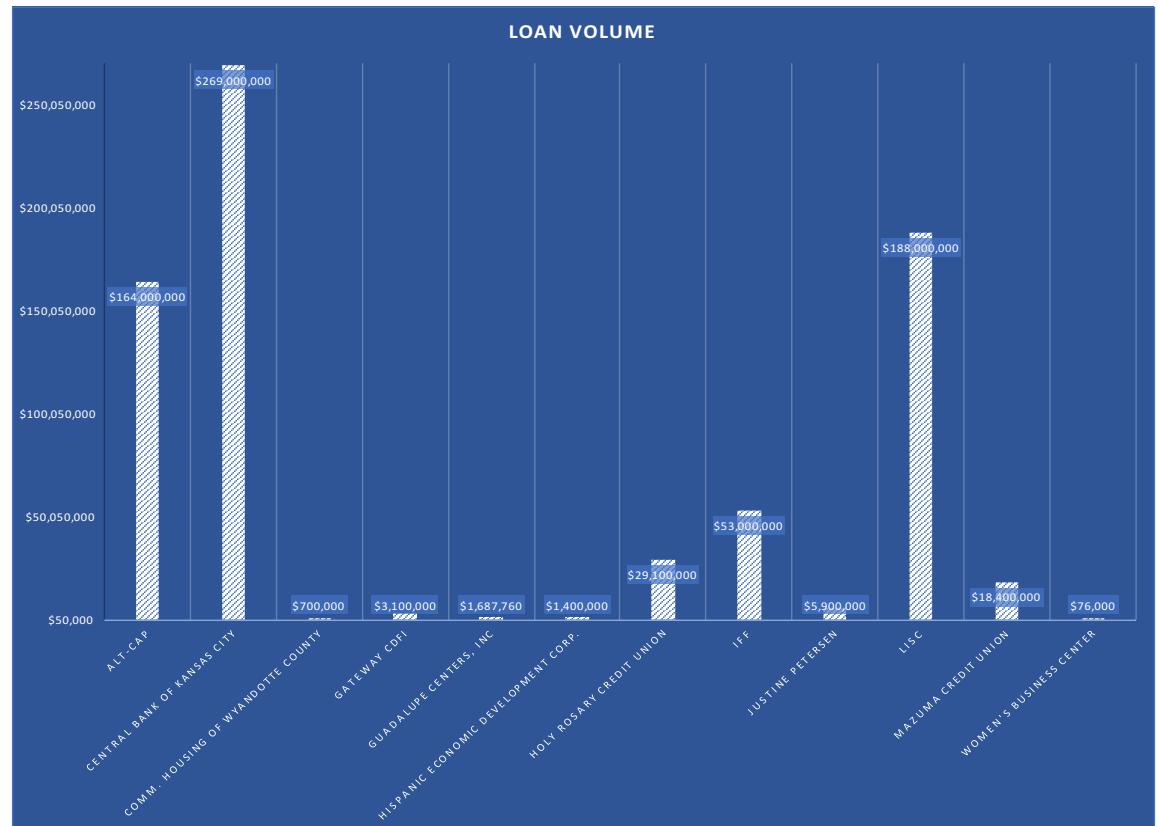


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The Kansas City CDFI Coalition

Founded in 2017, the CDFI Coalition has come together to:

- III. Raise awareness for the critical role CDFIs play in community development and the services offered.
- IV. Collaborate to drive innovative financial tools for high impact community investments.



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Community Development Finance Institutions (CDFIs)

CDFIs, a designation by the U.S. Department of Treasury, provide financial services to underserved areas where commercial banks and lenders leave gaps. Some specialize in mid to large loans to community-serving agencies; others provide small, individual loans, and other credit and financial services.

By nature of their non-profit status, all Coalition members offer mission-driven loans and other resources that tend to be more flexible and accessible than traditional financing. Loans and resources are deployed across the city into some of Kansas City's most economically distressed communities.
